Specific Procurement Notice for  
“Development of Sheola Land Port”  
(Request for Bids Works, Without Prequalification)

1. The Government of the People’s Republic of Bangladesh *has received* financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Bangladesh Regional Connectivity Project-I (Development of Sheola, Bhomra, Ramgarh Land Port and Safety Security and CCTV of Benapole Land Port) and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments under the contract for Development of Sheola Land Port.
2. The Bangladesh Land Port Authority now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for development of land port at Sheola including construction of buildings, pavements and other infrastructures as well as installation of necessary equipment and utilities as per the specifications and giving due attention to ESHS aspects so that the land port could be operated with all intended functions. The works are to complete in two years’ time. The bidders shall have construction experience of ten years, average annual construction turnover minimum USD 10.00 Million best three years of last five years, working capital/ liquid assets/ credit facilities of minimum USD 2.40 Million, similar experiences of two contracts each of value minimum USD 8.00 Million. More details are mentioned in the bid documents.
3. Bidding will be conducted through international competitive procurement using Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank’s “Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers- Procurement in Investment Projects Financing, July 2016” (“Procurement Regulations”), and is open to all eligible Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations.
4. Interested eligible Bidders may obtain further information from Bangladesh Land Port Authority; represented by Project Director, Bangladesh Regional Connectivity Project-I, e-mail: pdbcrc1blpa@gmail.com and inspect the Bidding document during office hours (in general 0900 to 1700 hours but in Ramadan 0900 to 15.30 hours ) at the address given below.
5. The Bidding document in English language may be purchased by interested eligible Bidders upon the submission of a written application to the address below and upon payment of a nonrefundable fee of BDT 25,000 or USD 300.00 or equivalent any freely convertible currency. The method of payment will be cash or pay order. The document will be sent by courier upon payment of courier fees or collected by the bidder directly from the office.
6. Bids must be delivered to the address below on or before June 20, 2019, 3.00 p.m. Local time (Local time is GMT + 6 Hours). Electronic Bidding will *not* be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders’ designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the address below on June 20, 2019, 3.15 p.m. Local time.
7. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid Security of US\$ 350,000.00 (Three Hundred Fifty Thousand US Dollar) or equivalent any freely convertible currency.
